
Guidelines

- The participants are required to submit their abstracts by 22 May 2025
- The participant should submit their abstract on UrjaVarta Website
- The abstract should be of 200-450 words
- The abstract should align to the themes as provide in the next page.
- The participant should provide the below mentioned fields while submitting their abstract through email:
 - Title of abstract:
 - Author:
 - Co-Author(s):
 - Contact no.:
 - Organization name:
 - Country:
 - Scope and objective of the abstract (25-75 words)
 - Approach and methodology including the process/procedures adopted (75-100 words)
 - Results, observations and conclusion of abstract (100-200 words)
 - Potential value-add enabled by the abstract in providing novel or additional information to the existing application or literature (25-75 words)

Evaluation Criteria



The submitted technical abstracts will be further screened and evaluated by an independent jury committee selected by DGH.



Post screening, the shortlisted candidates will be required to submit a white paper based on the technical abstract. White paper guidelines will be shared with shortlisted candidates.



The jury will conduct the evaluation of the white paper based on specified guidelines.



Post evaluation, the selected candidates will be informed to prepare presentation for the conclave. Details on presentation guidelines will be shared later.



The selected candidates will be invited to present their white paper in the Technical Conference or in the Exhibition Gallery at UrjaVarta 2025.

Please note: the decision taken by jury committee shall be considered final and imposing
